

Article 13. To see if the Town of Carroll will vote to raise and appropriate the sum of \$2,500 (Two Thousand Five Hundred Dollars) to hold a Household Hazardous Waste Collection Program. The Program will provide residents access to a Household Hazardous Waste Collection of household generated hazardous waste such as oil based paints, paint thinners, solvents, pesticides, gasoline and household cleaners. **Selectmen recommend this by a vote of 3 to 0. Budget Committee recommend this by a vote of 5 to 1. \$.01 Impact on Tax Rate.**

Article 14. To see if the Town will vote to raise and appropriate the sum of \$1,000 (One Thousand Dollars) for maintenance of the old landfill including but not limited to actual physical maintenance, engineering and overseer expenses, and further to authorize the withdrawal of this amount from the Landfill Closure Capital Reserve Fund established for this purpose. **No money will be raised from taxation. Selectmen recommend this by a vote of 3 to 0. Budget Committee recommend this by a vote of 4-0.**

Article 15. To see if the Town will vote to raise and appropriate the sum of \$6,993 (Six Thousand Nine Hundred Ninety Three Dollars) for improvements to the Town Hall building to help decrease fuel costs as follows: \$2,875 (Two Thousand Eight Hundred Seventy Five Dollars) for air sealing of Town Hall, \$1,700 (One Thousand Seven Hundred Dollars) for programmable thermostats and \$2,418 (Two Thousand Four Hundred Eighteen Dollars) for pipe insulation. These improvements are suggestions arising out of the Energy Audit approved and funded by the 2013 Town Meeting. **Selectmen recommend this by a vote of 3 to 0.
