

20. To see if the Town will vote to raise and appropriate \$30,000.00 (Thirty Thousand Dollars) to be placed in the New Land & Building Capital Reserve Fund.
21. To see if the Town will vote to raise and appropriate \$20,000.00 (Twenty Thousand Dollars) to be placed in the Water Improvement Capital Reserve Fund.
22. To see if the Town will vote to raise and appropriate the sum of \$38,000 (Thirty Eight Thousand Dollars) to purchase a new police cruiser and to authorize the withdrawal of \$25,000 (Twenty Five Thousand Dollars) from the Police Cruiser Capital Reserve Fund.
23. To see if the Town will vote to change the name of the Water Improvement Capital Reserve Fund to Water Department Capital Reserve Fund. Also to expand the purpose of the fund to be expended for improvements and emergency repairs to the water system and the purchase of vehicles and equipment. (Majority 2/3 vote needed.)
24. To see if the Town will vote to raise and appropriate the sum of \$9,500 (Nine Thousand Five Hundred Dollars) from water revenues to be placed in the Water Department Capital Reserve Fund. If the name change is not approved by vote in previous article, above named amount to be placed in the Water Improvement Capital Reserve Fund. No money will be raised from new taxation.
25. To see if the Town will vote to raise and appropriate the sum of \$57,000 (Fifty Seven Thousand Dollars) for the purpose of purchasing a dump truck with plow and sander for the Highway Department, and further, to authorize the withdrawal of that entire sum from the Highway Capital Reserve Fund created in 1980, with no amount to be raised from new taxation.
26. To see if the Town will vote to raise and appropriate the sum of \$4,000 (Four Thousand Dollars) to fund the Planning Board, Zoning Board of Appeals, and Zoning Enforcement Officer duties and further to authorize the withdrawal of such amount from the Planning Revenue Fund established in 2006, for that purpose.
27. To see if the town will vote to raise and appropriate the sum of \$30,000 (Thirty Thousand Dollars) for the purpose of paying off a portion of the principle of the bond approved at the 2003 Town Meeting to build the transfer/recycling station, and to authorize the withdrawal of that entire sum from the Recycling Equipment Special Revenue Fund established by the 2001 Town Meeting for that purpose. No money will be raised from new taxation.

28. To see if the Town of Carroll will vote to raise and appropriate the sum of Nine Hundred Four Dollars (\$904) as the Town's contribution to the Northern Human Services - White Mountain Mental Health and Common Ground, a non-profit mental health and development service center.

29. To raise and appropriate the sum of Two Thousand Dollars (\$2,000) to donate to the Tyler Blain House, Lancaster, NH, one of the only homeless shelters in northern NH.

30. To see if the Town of Carroll will vote to raise and appropriate the sum of Eight Hundred Seventy Five Dollars (\$875) payable to Littleton Regional Hospital, to help offset the cost of charity care and community benefit programs that Littleton Hospital provides.

31. To see if the Town will vote to raise and appropriate the sum of One Thousand One Hundred Sixty Seven Dollars (\$1,167) and turn over such monies to the Weeks Medical Center - Home Health & Hospice Services. The monies are used to provide home health care services to the residents of Carroll.

32. To see if the Town will vote to raise and appropriate the sum of Seven Hundred Fifty Dollars (\$750) for the support of preventative and primary health care services of Ammonoosuc Community Health Services, Inc. for the residents of Carroll.

33. To see if the Town will vote to raise and appropriate the sum of One Thousand Seven Hundred Ninety Seven Dollars (\$1,797) payable to North Country Home Health & Hospice Agency, Inc for the support of the home health care, supportive care, medical hospice and community health programs and services of North Country Home Health & Hospice Agency, Inc. and Hospice of the Littleton Area for the residents of Carroll.

34. To see if the Town will vote to raise and appropriate Three Hundred Fifty Five Dollars (\$355) for the American Red Cross.

35. To see if the Town will vote to raise and appropriate the sum of One Thousand Six Hundred Fifty Dollars (\$1,650) for the Caleb Interfaith Volunteer Caregivers that serves the needs of elderly people in the community.

36. To see if the Town will vote to raise and appropriate the sum of Five Hundred Dollars (\$500) for Court Appointed Special Advocates (CASA) of NH for recruiting, training and supervising volunteers who advocate in NH's courts for the best interests of abused and neglected children

37. To see if the Town will vote to raise and appropriate the sum of Eight Hundred Five Dollars (\$805) for Tri County Community Action Program in support of their services for the community

38 To see if the Town will vote to raise and appropriate the sum of Two Thousand Dollars (\$2,000) to the Coalition Communities in Portsmouth, New Hampshire consisting of 34 towns to represent the Town of Carroll in a solution to our educational funding crisis by opposing the establishment of donor towns and keeping the statewide property tax so that it can be used locally to fund our own education assessment from the White Mountain Regional School District.
