Good afternoon,

After careful review of the December 31, 2009 Source Area Delineation Report by Provan and Lorber, Inc., and a review of all available historic data collected, DES has determined that the release of petroleum discovered on September 5, 2008 is a manifestation of residual contamination resulting from historic release(s) from the site's previous underground storage tank facility. Therefore, all present and future work will be carried out under the site LUST Project # 519. All future reports shall reference this project.

Accordingly, DES will be closing out the LAST Project # 19856 and re-activating LUST Project #519. Therefore, payment of the \$5,000 deductible and submittal of the Late AST Registration Waiver are no longer required. Also, because the existing contamination is from the earlier release, a new project type will not be set up, nor will a \$5,000 deductible be required.
