## CARROLL POLICE MONTHLY REPORT

November calls for service 189

Shifts: officers took off 18 days for vacations, holidays ECT. Fourteen of these shifts were posted for part time officers; seven of these shifts were filled. There were seven shifts unfilled.

Vehicle report: Pickup truck is running fine, mileage 15875  
Ford – New police car has been delivered, currently waiting for parts to complete the up fitting.

Training: This month 3 officers were re certified for the Taser.

Incidents of major interest this month were the breaking and entering of Foster's General Store. Detective Brown currently has three arrest warrants for the suspects and this case will be solved which will now lead Detective Brown to court. There were 4 juvenile complaints filed, 1 domestic, 2 Breaking and Entering, 5 alarms, 5 calls outside of Carroll to assist other PD's.

At the request of the Selectman I have recruited two possible new part time officers. One officer is currently a full time officer in another town and is looking for part time work the other person is a returning veteran whom is looking into police work. Both of these individuals have been given a " Conditional Offer of Part Time Employment" pending backgrounds, and training requirements to be met. This paperwork has been sent to the Selectman for approval.

Building: There were a few electrical issues that needed to be addressed, have now been repaired, the building owner has had the heating system tuned for the winter and the safety committee is looking into a fireproof containment system for ammunition storage.
